

Medals

Medals are proof of your Team's devotion to the SensUs Competition. The goal is to increase the collaboration between all the stakeholders involved and promote your project. Your Team can use the medals alongside the certificates to promote and get recognition for your hard work throughout the whole SensUs Competition.

1. Criteria

In order to be awarded with a bronze, silver or gold medal, several criteria must be fulfilled before a set deadline. Please note, all documents must be sent as PDF to contact@sensus.org or uploaded to **SensUs Connect** if indicated.

1.1 Deadlines bronze medal

In order to be awarded with a bronze medal, your Team must fulfill all criteria of the bronze medal:

- 31.03.20** *Motivation.* Write a motivation describing what the main reason is for taking part in the SensUs Competition. The size of the motivation is max. 1 A4 per Team. The SensUs Organization can share your motivation on social media channels; please indicate if this is of your interest.
- 31.03.20** *Register on SensUs Connect.* All your Team members are registered on Connect.
- 13.04.20** *Register for SensUs Innovation Days.* All Team members who will attend the SensUs Innovation Days need to be registered before the registration deadline. Withdrawal of Team members before April 20th is allowed. Registration and deregistration after these deadlines means that this criterion is not met.
- 31.06.20** *Ideas of the Team.* Deliver a document (1 A4) which describes which ideas of the biosensor originate from the Team itself. The document needs to be signed by both the Team Captains and the Supervisor of the Team. More information will follow in a future iteration of the Information Package.
- 20.08.20** *Final documents.* Deliver all the documents requested by the SensUs Organization in time to contact@sensus.org or to **SensUs Connect** if indicated. All deadlines can be found in the latest version of the Information Package. It is permitted to miss at most 1 deadline to still meet this criterion.

1.2 Deadlines silver medal

In order to be awarded with a silver medal, your Team must fulfill all criteria of the bronze and silver medals. Your Team is allowed to miss two silver criteria.

- 01.05.20** *Interviews with patients and/or medical professionals.* Show that your Team did research on the impact of epilepsy by means of interviewing patients or medical professionals. The results should be filled in the template found in *Appendix 2. Template Medals*.

- 25.05.20 *Quiz about the IP.* A quiz about the Information Package will be sent together with the Information Package of May. The answers of the quiz should be handed in in your group on **SensUs Connect**. In order to meet this criterion, you need to score at least 9/10. All questions will be based on the Information Package of May.
- 31.06.20 *Meet with Alumni or other Team.* Organize a meeting with SensUs Alumni or other currently registered Teams. The objective of this event should be filled in the template found in *Appendix 2. Template Medals*.
- 31.06.20 *Tips for subsequent SensUs Teams.* Make a Tips & Tricks document which is useful for Teams of later editions. The document should be at least one A4 (min. 25 tips or tricks). You can make it one story or divide it into subsections or separate tips.
- 01.08.20 *Mail exchange with a SensUs partner.* Have a mailing conversation with at least one partner (e.g. a partner whom you met at Kick-off Meet the Partners) about your own biosensor according to their expertise. This could include asking questions about equipment, asking for technical advice or professional input on the business plan of your biosensor. You need to CC **contact@sensus.org** to your mail in order to meet this criterion.
- 16.08.20 *Reposts on social media.* Republish at least 3 posts from the public SensUs social media channels (i.e. Facebook, Instagram, YouTube) on your Team's social media by choice. A repost on SensUs Connect does not count, as it is not a public platform.

1.3 Deadlines gold medal

In order to be awarded with a gold medal, your Team must fulfill all criteria of the bronze, silver, and gold medals. Your Team is allowed to miss 2 silver and 1 gold criterion.

- 31.04.20 *Design of the biosensor.* The Team clarifies in a document why they chose the specific design of their biosensor. A sketch/photo of the model should be included.
- 31.07.20 *Present at a professional event.* Promote your Team at a professional event (i.e. congress, symposium, seminar, workshop) by giving a pitch about your biosensor and the SensUs Competition. Please fill in the objective of this event in the template found in *Appendix 2. Template Medals*.
- 01.08.20 *Skype meetings with SensUs partner.* Have a content-rich Skype session with at least one partner whom you met at Kick-off Meet the Partners about your own biosensor according to their expertise. This could, for example, include asking questions about equipment, asking for technical advice or professional input on the business plan of your biosensor. Please fill in the objective of this event in the template found in *Appendix 2. Template Medals* and CC **contact@sensus.org** when arranging the Skype session.
- 16.08.20 *Post on SensUs Connect every month.* Post once per month on the live feed of the SensUs Connect platform. The content of your post is free of choice (e.g. an article, movie, interview, event). Do note: Posting on SensUs Connect should start from February up to August.
